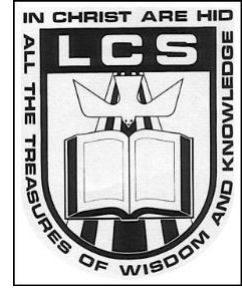

We look forward to Mrs Sizemore's safe return on Monday.

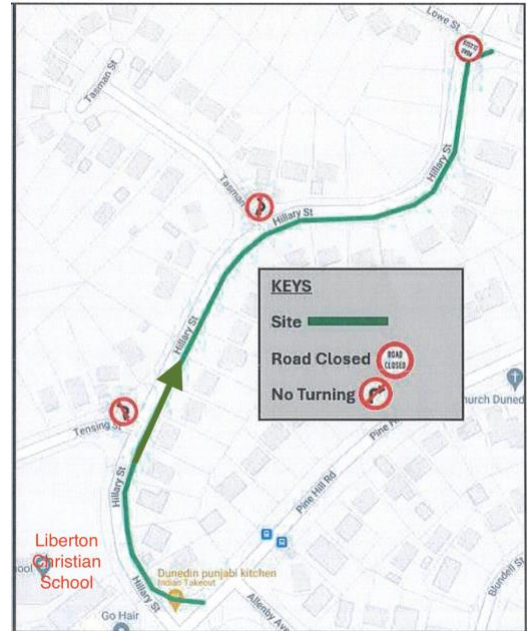

Road Works in Hillary Street

The kerb and channel on the opposite side of Hillary Street to the school is due to be renewed. Work is scheduled to begin next Monday (5 August). This will see Hillary Street reduced to a one way system, with vehicles entering Hillary Street at the LCS end and returning to Pine Hill Road via Lowe street (see map). The contractor, Downer, intends to begin work at the Lowe Street end and work towards LCS.

This will impact on street parking, drop-offs and pick-ups, especially at peak times. There will still be parking available on the LCS side of Hillary Street. Connecting streets such as Tensing Street are unaffected excepting that no right-hand turn will be possible when intersecting with Hillary Street. Please take extra care while these works are in place.
